
School Accountability Committee

This is the time of year when many kids shift from a summer schedule which can often include different sleep patterns and bedtimes, to a school schedule with more regularity in their sleep patterns. The American Academy of Pediatrics states that children ages 6-13 need 9-12 hours of sleep each night, with most kids needing between 10-11 hours! Kids aged 3-5 need 10-13 hours of sleep each night.

- Mental/physical health

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
